Mini Golf League Rules



League Rules

- Players may use their own putter or one of THGC's provided putters
- Players must use THGC provided ball
- Players will play in teams of 2 in a best ball format (lowest score between teammates each hole)
- Teams may be co-ed
- If a team member is under the age of 18, they must have a parent/guardian accompany them
- Players will play against another 2 person team each week
 - Winning team will receive 4 points
 - Losing team will receive 0 points
 - Tie results in each team receiving 2 points
- A running total of points for league season will determine 4 team playoff bracket resulting in 2 semi-final matches, winners of which will play in the championship match on last week of the season.
- No "gimmies", ball must be putted out each hole unless player reaches stroke limit
- Stroke limit of 7 on each hole. If a player hits 7 times without putting the ball in the hole, that player may pick up and write a 7 for that hole on the scorecard
- Any ball stuck along the bricks may be moved 1 putter head length away with no penalty
- Ball cannot be played from "out of bounds" area such as rocks or water. A ball hit out of bounds must be replaced from where the shot was previously hit and take a 1 stroke penalty.
- A ball hit in water must be placed back on the hole at the closest point of entry from where it went in the water and take a 1 stroke penalty
- If a player's ball is contacted by another ball rules go as follows:
 - Ball A hits Ball B, the owner of Ball B may choose to return the ball to its original position OR to leave the ball in it's new position. Ball A cannot be moved and must be played from where it came to a stop
 - If contact from Ball A puts Ball B into the hole, Ball B must be replaced to its original position.
 - If ball A contacts Ball B and ball A goes into the hole. That is considered a make for Ball A

<u>Schedule</u>

- League Fee must be paid before first week of play
- Mini-golf league will be played each Wednesday for 8 weeks
 - Week 9 will be semi-final and championship matches

- Teams playing against each other do not have to play together at the same time each week. (Excluding playoff matches in week 9)
- Scorecards are to be turned in to pro shop after each round. Results will be posted each week on the bulletin board by pro shop entrance
- There will be no league held on Wednesday, July 3rd
 - Play will resume July 10th
- Teams may play at any time each Wednesday

Sportsmanship

- This league is intended for a fun night out and everyone is expected to display proper sportsmanship during matches. This includes no yelling or profanity to distract opponents. We will be a family oriented league and all players are expected to act appropriately. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and players that do not follow proper sportsmanship or behavior will be removed from the league without a refund.
